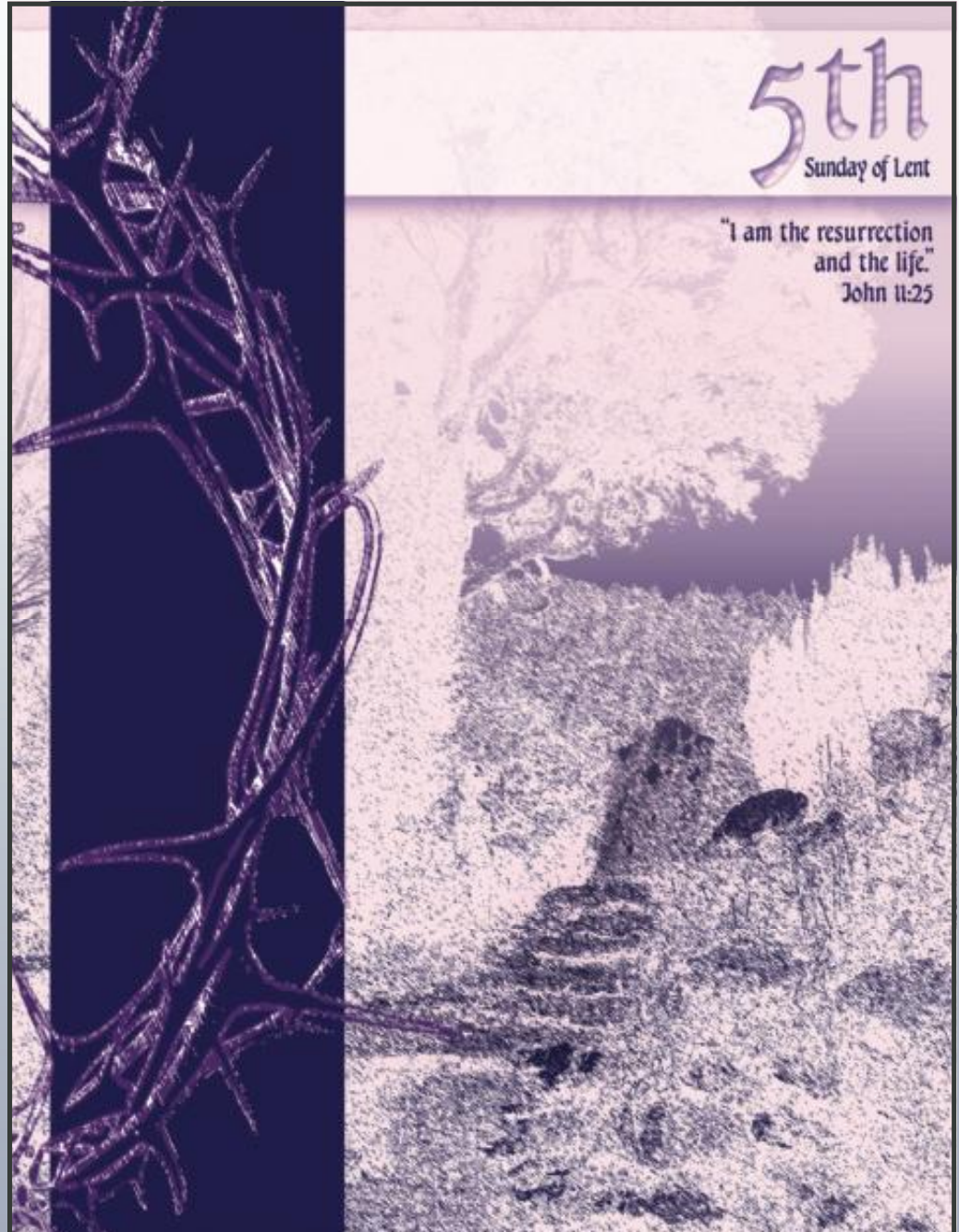

## GOSPEL REFLECTION

Jesus tells Martha plainly, "Your brother will rise again." Martha and Mary understandably have a certain measure of doubt, as if this is possible, by telling Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here my brother would not have died" Also, Martha later informs Jesus, as if He would not know, "Lord by this time there will be an odor for he has been dead four days". Jesus reassures her that she would "see the glory of God." After Jesus prayed, "He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus come out" And Lazarus does just that.

When Jesus is determined to work His will in our lives through His power, He is unconcerned with our doubts and human limitations. The 11th hour means nothing to Jesus. For indeed the hour of Lazarus was beyond the 12th hour of his death and four days down. Jesus Christ is the Son of God and has the power to revive and resuscitate us to new life in the Holy Spirit. Whatever situation, sin or other form of death is separating us from the life of grace that God has for us, Jesus CAN remove the barrier. What about you? Can you hear the voice of Jesus Christ calling you to "come out" and to "Unbind him and let him go"? Go to Him now with whatever concern you have. Our LIBERTY is in Him.

# Do you really know the *Mass*?

**A**men This is our response of assent, approval, agreement. It is our statement that we believe and endorse all that has gone before. We call this the "great Amen," because, although there are many throughout the liturgy, this is the big one. This is our agreement, "so it is," to the wonderful prayer that we call the Eucharistic Prayer. Of all the parts of the Mass that are to be sung, this is the most important, because our response at this time is so important. It is our statement of faith and praise. It is our agreement to the whole action. Just as we offered our gifts, financial or otherwise, as a statement of our willingness to be part of this celebration and as a symbol of our willingness to be transformed with the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, so our hearty and heartfelt "Amen" vocally asserts this intention.

**E**l Amén Esta es nuestra respuesta para asentir, aprobar y estar de acuerdo. Es nuestra declaración de que creemos y avalamos todo lo que acaba de llevarse a cabo. Lo denominamos el "gran Amén", dado que, a pesar de que hay muchos a lo largo de la liturgia, este el grande. 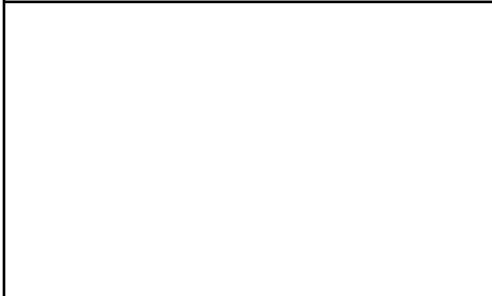

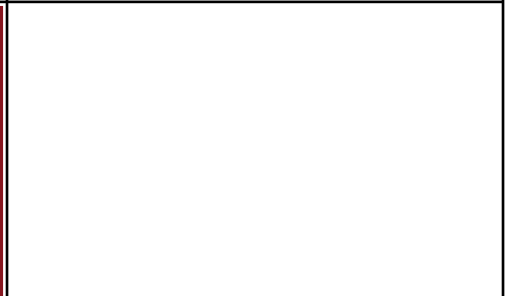
