### **Just Faith: A testimonial by parishioner Frank Madden**

*We are all created in the image of God, so it was drilled into those of us who came up under the Baltimore Catechism of old. As time moves on we have a tendency to forget this, but at St. Thomas a class offered through adult faith formation, started a program almost four years ago that challenges individuals to change the world.*

*The Just Faith program has graduated a group of people who took it upon themselves to make a difference in the life of the poor on the streets of Atlanta. Every Saturday morning about 10:00 a.m., they meet to load a van with sandwiches, eggs, fruit, chips, cookies, and water, all of which is donated by church members, many who are graduates of the program, and others who are interested in helping the less fortunate. The goal is to distribute to a group of the forgotten and marginalized people on Hollowell Parkway, less than 8 miles from the church. The area was known as the combat zone when the street was called Bankhead Highway. In a mile and half stretch running from I-285 East to Holmes Ave, it has a large community of practicing alcoholics, crack addicts, and the transient looking for work as well as the working poor. **To paraphrase Dorothy Day, we look at the face of Christ among those who are considered the garbage of humanity.***

Fr. James Caffery, M.S., arrived at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish in the summer of 1995.

As pastor, Fr Caf welcomed many new parishioners to our parish community. Such rapid growth was the driving force behind the many changes that Fr. Caf implemented, the first one being the doubling of the scheduled masses for the weekend liturgies in order to accommodate the spiritual needs of our increasing population. Other changes that Fr. Caf was instrumental in bringing about due to the growth in the parish were: the addition of a parking area added at the rear of the church as well as the creation of another exit to help alleviate traffic congestion during the weekend masses; a new rectory to house the clergy assigned to serve our growing flock;

expansion and renovations to the Parish Office; a new roof for the church and education building; and a reconfiguration of our original Social Hall which added 4 new classrooms to accommodate the growing need for Religious Education, a new St. Vincent de Paul food pantry and an office for our music staff as well as a rehearsal room for our choirs.

Fr. Caf was a tireless, devoted pastor during his years at St. Thomas. He had a great affection for the elderly, the lonely, and the sick and made weekly visits to the homebound, to those in nursing homes and to area hospitals. He took great pleasure in celebrating with us throughout the years - weddings, baptisms, First Eucharist, parish missions, holiday dinners, etc.

Our Lord called Fr. Caf to his final home on Friday, June 17. Although he had been gone from St. Thomas for seven years, his death surprised and saddened many of us. A Memorial Mass was celebrated on Thursday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> at St. Thomas. Our sanctuary was filled with the prayers of many priests from the La Salette community and the diocese, deacons and an acolyte. As the loving prayers were offered to God on behalf of this dear servant of the people of St. Thomas, many caring parishioners were also on hand.

Personal stories are being remembered by those who knew Fr. Caf. Among his many attributes we fondly remember his great sense of humor which he gladly shared with whomever was around when he saw the funnier side of life. He had many friends in the parishes where he had served and among his La Salette brothers. He was encouraging to others, especially younger priests; and while at St. Thomas, he tapped several men who in time became deacons in our parish.

El Padre James Caffery, M.S. llegó a la parroquia Santo Tomás en el verano de 1995.

Como párroco, el Padre Caf le dio la bienvenida a nuestra comunidad parroquial a muchos nuevos feligreses.

El rápido crecimiento de nuestra comunidad parroquial fue la razón principal que impulsó al Padre Caf a implementar muchos cambios en la parroquia, empezando por aumentar el número de Misas de los fines de semana para poder acomodar las necesidades espirituales de nuestra creciente comunidad. Otros cambios que el Padre Caf llevó a cabo fueron: la adición de un estacionamiento detrás de la iglesia, así como la creación de una salida adicional en la parte trasera de la propiedad para aliviar el tráfico de las Misas de fin de semana.

El Padre Caf también ordenó la construcción de una nueva rectoría para alojar a los sacerdotes que sirven a nuestra comunidad; la expansión y renovación de la Oficia Parroquial; un nuevo techo para la iglesia y el edificio de Catecismo; y la remodelación de nuestro Salón Social con lo cual se logró añadir 4 nuevos salones de clase para Educación Religiosa, una nueva despensa para la Sociedad de San Vicente de Paúl y una oficina de música, así como un cuarto adicional para que los coros ensayen.

El Padre Caf fue un párroco incansable y devoto durante sus años en Santo Tomás. Sentía gran aprecio por las personas mayores, los abandonados, los enfermos, y solía hacer visitas semanales a los hospitales y albergues de ancianos. Durante muchos años de servicio nos acompañó en la celebración de bodas, bautismos, Primeras Comuniones, misiones parroquiales y cenas aquí en la iglesia Santo Tomás el Apóstol.

El Padre Caf fue llamado a la presencia del Señor el viernes, 17 de junio.

A pesar de haberse marchado de Santo Tomás hace más de siete años, su muerte llenó de tristeza a muchos. En su memoria, se ofreció una Misa el pasado jueves, 23 de junio, en Santo Tomás. Nuestro santuario se llenó con plegarias de muchos sacerdotes de la comunidad de La Salette, y también de la arquidiócesis. Se unieron al memorial muchos feligreses de Santo Tomás al tiempo que se elevaban al cielo las plegarias ofrecidas por este querido siervo de Dios.

Durante la celebración, se compartieron historias de aquellos que conocieron al Padre Caf. Dentro de sus atributos, recordamos con cariño su gran sentido del humor que alegremente compartía con otros para enseñarnos el lado positivo de la vida. Tuvo muchos amigos en las parroquias en las que sirvió y entre sus hermanos Saletenses.

Siempre mostró apoyo a otros, especialmente jóvenes sacerdotes; y durante su tiempo en Santo Tomás, alentó a algunos para seguir la vocación del diaconado.

# Do you really know the *Mass*?

Learn about the New Roman Missal

## Greeting

At the beginning of Mass the celebrant extends one of three different liturgical greetings to the people. The one that is perhaps most commonly used is "The Lord be with you." It is a familiar line that will remain unchanged with the new translation.

However, our new response will be the first major change. Instead of "And also with you," we will now be saying, "And with your spirit." This new response will also be made at the four other times during Mass when this dialogue occurs.

## Why the change?

Now, there is practical reason for the change to the response "And with your spirit" is the proper translation of the original Latin text: "Et cum spiritu tuo."

Furthermore, we all know, the priest acts *in persona Christi*, or in the person of Christ. This is most evident when he is saying Mass, and celebrating the sacraments. During ordination, the priest received an ontological change, which means that his spirit has been for ever marked with the sign of Christ, and can now act *in persona Christi*. Since we know that the priest is acting *in persona Christi*, and thus has the spirit of Christ within him, does it not make sense that we should be addressing Christ, and not the priest? In fact, whenever we are making responses for anything at Mass, we are talking to Christ's spirit acting through the priest to change the bread and wine into his body and blood. So, basically, we are not talking to the priest, but to Christ's spirit within the priest, and thus the reason for the change from "and also with you" to "and with your spirit."

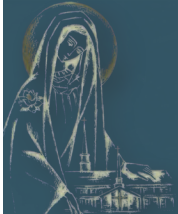
