Registration Fees: All students must pay a non-refundable registration fee as follows:

St. Thomas the Apostle Parishioner \$125/per child or \$200/family

Non-Parishioner \$150 per child or \$250/family

Two-Year-Old Program: Must be 2 by September 1, 2014

Gradual entry 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. during first two weeks

Must have completed one year of Pre-K

A certified copy of your child's birth certificate must be presented to the preschool office at the time of registration. A photocopy of the birth certificate will be kept in your child's file and the original certified copy will be returned to you.
